

Huey Adventure Flights – April 2010



Fine Print – Terms and Conditions

If you take an adventure flight in Limited Category aircraft, you will be asked to sign a document acknowledging you have been told and understand the risks involved. Please see **Page 2**

Page 2 MUST be signed, dated and **returned to us** either with payment or before payment.

Children aged under 15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age. One adult per two children. No children under two years of age permitted. Parents / Guardians must sign for children under 18 years of age.

A good level of mobility is required.

You need to be able to get in and out of a helicopter unassisted (like getting in a 4WD vehicle – come and visit us to have a practice run if unsure!).

Safety briefing given in English – you need to be able to understand the safety briefing and be able to follow emergency procedures. Precision Helicopters staff will be coordinating safety around the helicopter and it is important that you follow their instructions at all times.

Weight Considerations – please advise us if you weigh over 100kg, this is for weight and balance limitations of the helicopter and for passenger comfort.

No bags, hats, scarves, mobile phones, keys or loose items can be carried on the flight. All cameras must have a reliable strap that can be attached securely to your wrist or neck.

Sturdy, flat footwear must be worn. No thongs, slip on sandals or inappropriate footwear.

Ticket / seat can be transferred to another person – please notify us with name change ASAP.

Seating will be allocated by loading crew on the day, you cannot request seating.

No refunds will be given.

You will be **refused carriage** and **no refunds given** if:

You have not returned the signed Page 2 document.

You arrive late and miss your helicopter safety briefing.

You cannot understand the safety briefing and follow safety instructions.

You are drunk or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

You are wearing thongs / slip on sandals or inappropriate footwear.

You cannot get in or out of the helicopter unassisted.

You have used threatening, abusive or insulting words towards our ground staff or a member of the crew of the helicopter or otherwise behaved in a threatening manner.

Your mental or physical state is a danger or risk to You, the helicopter or any person in it.

Flight may be rescheduled to alternate time / day if weather delays your booked flight, please ensure a contact phone number is provided for that day.

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This Page **MUST** be signed, dated and returned to us.

One per person(seat).

If you take an adventure flight in Limited Category aircraft, you will be asked to sign a document acknowledging you have been told and understand the risks involved.

The risks I must accept are:

- the design, manufacture, and airworthiness of the aircraft are not required to meet any standard recognised by CASA
- CASA does not require the aircraft to be operated to the same degree of safety as an aircraft on a commercial passenger flight
- a person who flies in limited category aircraft does so at his or her own risk.
